Brief Introduction to the Tourist Spots

◆ Kennedy Town (Free)



Kennedy Town, originally written as Kennedy Town, is commonly known as "Sai Wan Tail" (meaning the end of Sai Wan). It is backed by Mount Davis in the south, faces Belcher Bay in the north, faces Green Island and Big and Small Island across the sea in the west, and is connected to Shek Tong Tsui in the east. Its scope includes Sai Ning Street to the junction of Belcher Street and Queen's Road West.

◆ Golden Bauhinia Square (Free)

The Golden Bauhinia Square is located next to the Wanchai Convention and Exhibition Center. On the square stands the Golden Bauhinia Bronze Statue to commemorate the return of the People's Republic of China. Here you can watch the solemn flag raising ceremony. The square is surrounded by Victoria Harbour on three sides and faces Tsim Sha Tsui across the sea. The full name of the 6-meter-high bronze statue is "Bauhinia that blooms forever", which means prosperity.



◆ Victoria Peak

(Tickets: 25 USD Per Person, include Round-trip Peak Tram and Sky Terrace 428)

Hong Kong Island's The Peak is the highest point on Hong Kong Island, offering expansive views where you can see as far as Lantau Island, panoramic vistas of Hong Kong, and admire layered skyscrapers and the night view of Harbour. Combined with the Sky Terrace observation deck and the Peak Tram, it has become a major tourist attraction and one of Hong Kong's iconic landmarks.

◆ Victoria Harbour (Free)



Victoria Harbour, one of the world's three major natural harbours, is located in Hong Kong, China. It lies between Hong Kong Island and the Kowloon Peninsula, covering a water area of approximately 41.88 square kilometers with an average water depth of 12 meters, and can accommodate a large number of large vessels.

◆ Avenue of Stars HK (Free)

The Avenue of Stars, modeled on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, is located along the Victoria Harbour waterfront in Tsim Sha Tsui. It honors celebrities of Hong Kong film industry. Along the 440 m promenade, the story of Hong Kong's one hundred years of cinematic history is told through inscriptions printed on nine red pillars. Set into the promenade are plaques honoring the celebrities. The Avenue of Stars commands a stunning panoramic view across Victoria Harbour.
